- *Go on a retreat. It's a way to be merciful to yourself and the people around you, who know you need to go on a retreat.*

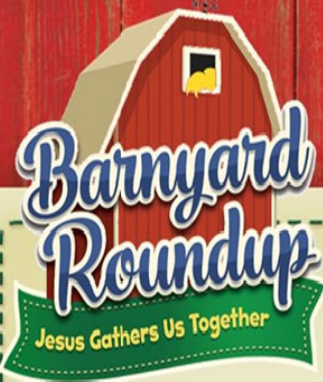

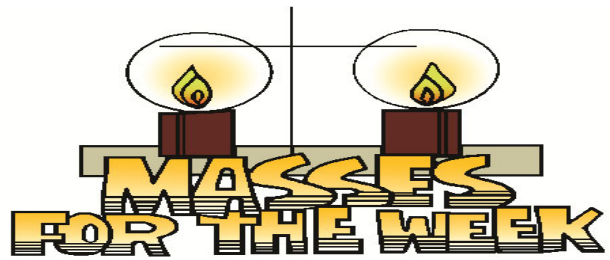
