

RENEW & REBUILD CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Every ten years the Archdiocese of New York has a major capital campaign for all the parishes. The campaign this year is called "**Renew + Re-build**". This campaign will run for approximately three years until all parishes in the archdiocese have participated. We were one of 12 parishes chosen to be a "pilot" parish. Before this campaign is formally and officially inaugurated in other parishes, it is worked on by the parishioners of 12 parishes and then will be rolled out this fall in a number of other parishes. This campaign seeks to raise \$200 million dollars. Each parish has been given a goal. **Our goal is \$1.7 million.** This goal was established as a result of doubling our average Sunday collection for the past three years.

Our parish will receive back 74% of the total pledges that are received. The remaining 24% will go to the works and needs of the Archdiocese of NY. There are a number of projects that we will be working on here at St. Augustine Parish.

The parish owes TD Bank \$1.3 million on the church that was built 15 years ago as well as \$550,000 for a loan from the archdiocese for purchasing the new parking lot. We will use \$750,000 for the reduction of the church and parking lot loan. In addition, we will also use funds for a renovation of the rectory (built in the 1920's) as well as repave the school parking lot. Also, we anticipate doing some work in the school toward repurposing the facility for both adult as well as children's formation in faith, installing LED lighting for energy efficiency throughout the church and Zoeller Center, as well as, the parking lot. We are also examining the benefit of adding gas as well as oil for heating the school.

As of last Sunday we have raised in pledges \$1,143,000 toward our \$1,737,000.00 goal, This represents 65% of our goal from only 95 families. This has been astounding and manifests the ongoing generosity of our parishioners. **Next Sunday, we will be asking all of our parishioners to make a pledge to the campaign. We emphasize the word "pledge"** We would ask you to prayerfully consider **what your family could give each year for a five year period.** If you cannot make a pledge but can give a one-time gift; that too is deeply appreciated. If you cannot give at this time there is one thing everyone can do: **PRAY FOR THE CAMPAIGN'S SUCCESS.**

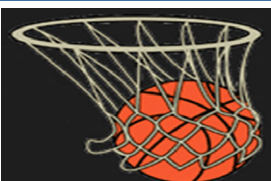

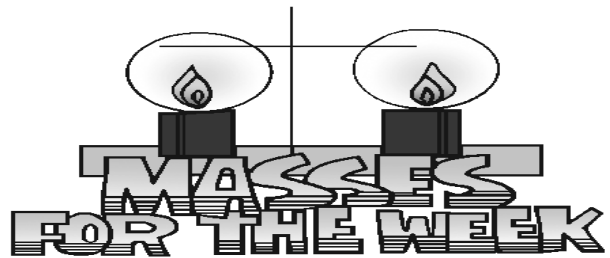
